Applications received 300	Applications received 499	66% increase
Applications reviewed 237	Applications reviewed 364	54% increase
Awards funded 119 (50%)	Awards funded 145 (40%)	22% increase
Funds awarded \$3,511,189	Funds awarded \$4,631,455	32% increase
