d. Advancement to Health Sciences Clinical Professor, Step VI and Above Scale Status

(1) Advancement to Step VI

The normal period of service is three years in each of the first four steps. Service at Step V may be of indefinite duration. Advancement to Step VI usually will not occur before at least three years of service at Step V; it involves an overall career review and may be granted on evidence of sustained and continuing excellence in the following categories:

(1) teaching, (2) professional competence and activity, (3) scholarly or creative achievement, and (4) service. Above and beyond that, great distinction in academic health sciences, recognized at least regionally, will be required in teaching and professional competence and activity. Service at Step V or higher may be of indefinite duration. Advancement from Step VI to Step VII, from Step VII to Step VIII, and from Step VIII to Step IX usually will not occur before at least three years of service at the lower step, and will only be granted on evidence of continuing achievement at the level for advancement to Step VI.
