

What is a Clinician Educator?



How do I get started on this pathway?

- 1. Make interests known (colleagues, leaders, mentors)
- 2. Volunteer to teach
 - Get trainee feedback
 - Get TOPed (AME)
- 3. Gain skills! (next slide)
- 4. Find a mentor with experience
- 5. Find a community (local and national)

How do I gain skills/expertise?

- 1. UCSF Center for Faculty Educators
 - Workshops: teaching (all types), curriculum design, etc.
 - Teaching Scholars Program
- 2. Learn the literature
 - Read Med Ed Journals (Academic Medicine, etc...)
 - ESCAPE, Med Ed Journal Club
- 3. Other external opportunities

How do I show my value, display my work, and get promoted?

- 1. Show value: share work at division meetings, ask to be nominated for teaching awards, SoMe
- 2. Display work:
 - Educator Portfolio (part of Advance)
 - Education Day, regional, national education meetings
- 3. Find sponsors locally and nationally
