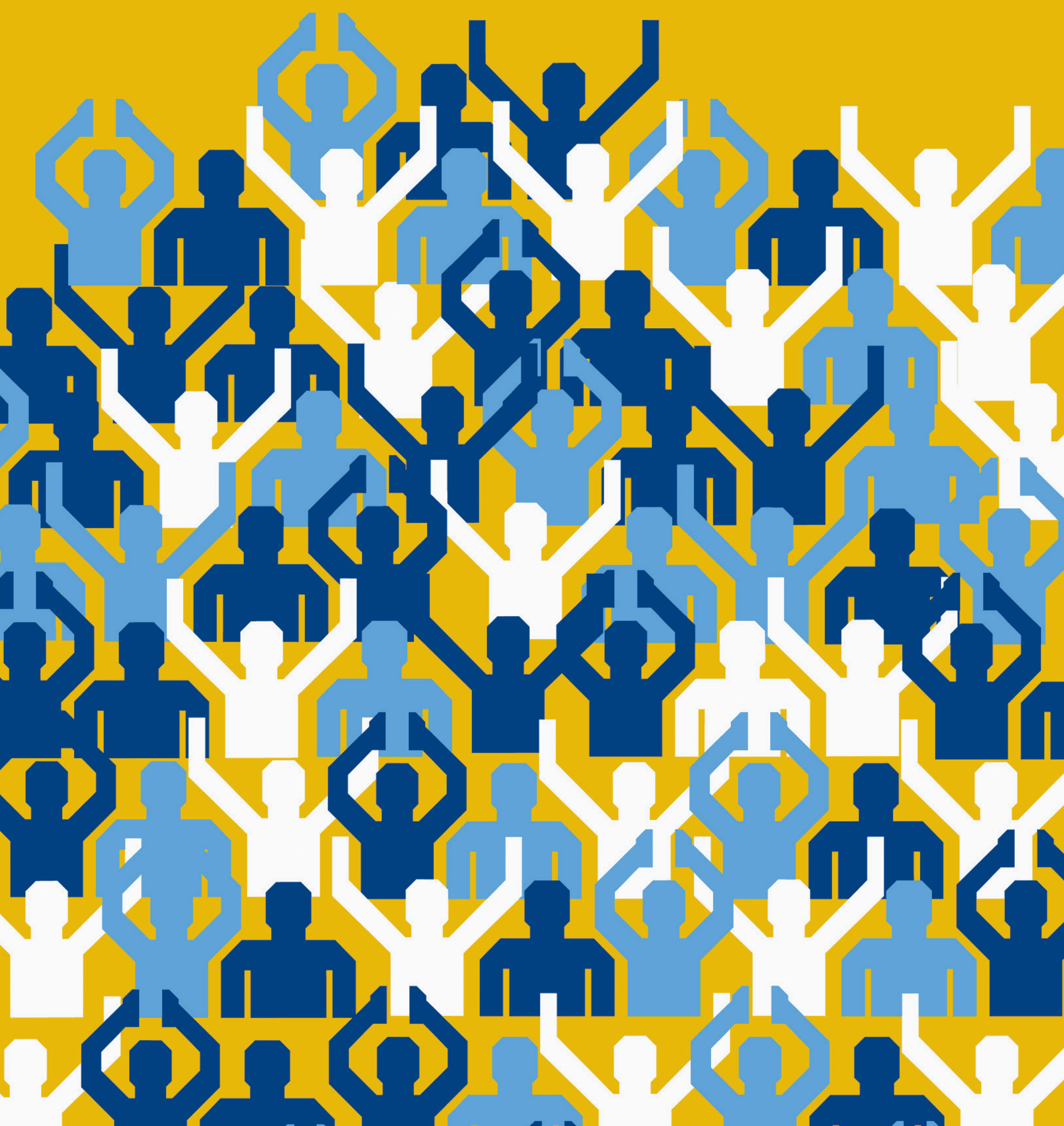

Reverse Mentoring: Stories of Managing Up in a Mentoring Relationship

Successful mentoring requires active engagement from both the mentor and mentee. Mentees in particular must learn how to ‘manage up’ — to take initiative of and direct the mentoring relationship, letting the mentor know what he or she needs.
