On January 31st, EVCP Lowenstein <u>announced</u> his support of the recommendations that emerged from the Faculty Family-Friendly Initiative (3FI) report, including a three-year investment of campus funds to implement these recommendations. I am pleased to announce that the 3FI implementation is underway:

- 1) We have hired a project manager, Vaishali Patel, who will partner with our office, faculty and other stakeholders to put the report recommendations in place.
- 2) In order to better understand the experiences, awareness and perceptions of faculty regarding family-friendly policies and practices at UCSF and to assess the impact of 3FI on our faculty and climate a small working group led by faculty member <u>Jennifer Kerns, MD, MS, MPH</u>, will conduct a formal assessment through pre- and post-3FI implementation surveys (3FI Goal 7).

Next week you will receive an email and survey link on behalf of <u>Dr. Jennifer Kerns</u>, <u>Dr. Christina Mangurian</u> and myself. I urge you to fill out this survey – it should only take about 15 minutes of your time and it is confidential and anonymous.
